

The Competitors

The Trophée des Montagnes allows for participation at any age or level, from beginner to European Champion. The 2010 event saw representatives from ten nations: Germany, England, France, Belgium, Scotland, Spain, Holland, The Czech Republic and Switzerland, there was even a representative from Canada. 2011 should see some new nations.

Registration

Adult Entries are limited to 150 for the entire event and are available from each resort tourist office, partner of the Federation of sports and Leisure Canine or online at the official Trophée des montagnes 2011 website.

Closing date for all entries is the 14th July 2011 however anyone can enter for one or more of the stages.

THE TESTS

11 races of between 4 and 8.5 km over 9 days, with classification in specific categories, against the clock, including mass and staggered starts and night races.
